The American Medallic Sculptors Association (AMSA) announced their award for the 2021 American Medal of the Year (AMY). It was presented to Jeanne Stevens Sullman for her medal honoring George Floyd.

The cast bronze medal is 95mm diameter, or about 3.75 inches. The edition is limited to 25 pieces. Original issue price was \$200 plus \$12 shipping.
